S(P)EEDKITS demonstration of prototypes

MSF Belgium site November 18 at 17:30 and November 19 at 11:30

Several prototype kits developed within S(P)EEDKITS will be on display at the MSF Belgium test site in the Port of Brussels.

Displayed prototypes include several shelter types, a concrete recycling kit, a water tower kit, a faecal sludge pasteuriser, a water drilling kit and a command centre including communication kit and tracking software.

Two demonstration moments are planned: November 18 at 17:30 (including reception) and November 19 at 11:30 (including sandwich lunch).

A shuttle bus will be organised from AidEx to the MSF site. We will gather at the S(P)EEDKITS booth at 16:50 and at 10:50 respectively. Expected time of visit in total ca. 2 hours, then return to the AidEx fair area (individual earlier return possible).
