

HOW TO APPLY FOR A STUDENT JOB ON OUR VUB JOB BOARD

1. Go to <http://studentenjobs.vub.ac.be> (no login or password needed)

2. You can find all available student jobs by selecting all **selection criteria**. The available student jobs are showed chronologically (the most recent student job is shown as first).

If you are looking for a specific student job (specific type of job, specific function category, etc.), you can select those selection criteria who meet your requirements: *function category, type of job, vacancy number and/or if student jobs are open for non-Dutch or French speaking students.*

3. If you found a student job you are interested in, you can see more information about this specific student job by clicking on the function tittle (text in blue). If you do so, you can find all the information about the employer, the location, your salary, description of the work, etc.

You also must mention if you are a VUB or EhB student, if you are a PhD student and if you are a non-EEA student. 6. The further process of your application depends on the type of job you applied for. There are 2 possibilities: you applied for a VUB job or you candidated for a non-VUB job

- A. **Application for a VUB job:** your application will go directly to the service/department/faculty of the VUB who is looking for a student. The contact person of this service/department/faculty will receive an e-mail with your application. He/she will decide to invite you for a job interview and will contact you for more information.

- B. **Application for a non-VUB job:** your application will go directly to a colleague of *student jobs*. This colleague will verify your profile to see if this matches the requirements of the job vacancy.

If there is a match, the colleague of *student jobs* will send you the contact information of the employer, so you can apply for this non-VUB job vacancy you are interested in. It is this employer who decides if you will get an invitation for a job interview.

If there is no match, you will not receive the contact information of the employer. Instead, a colleague of *student jobs* will explain you why there is not a match between your profile and (the requirements of) the job vacancy you are interested in. In this case, you can search for another student job on our VUB job board.

IMPORTANT: if you have indicated that you are a PhD student or a non-EEA-student and/or if you have indicated that you are no VUB or EhB student, your application will go directly to a colleague of *student jobs* (nevertheless this is a VUB or non-VUB job).

This is because there are some strict regulations you need to follow if you want to work as a PhD or a non-EEA student. In this case, you are screened to see if you can work as a student. If you are a no VUB or EhB student, it is not possible to apply for jobs on our VUB job board.
