

Programme Changes 2024-2025Master in Political Sciences: European and International Governance

Starting from academic year 2024-2025, the master's programme will undergo two significant curriculum changes.

- 1. The mandatory course 'Research Design and Methodology' disappears from the programme.
- 2. Students will be required to take elective courses.

1. the mandatory course 'Research Design and Methodology' disappears from the programme

For students who enrolled in the programme in 2023-2024 or earlier, there is an alteration that may affect your study path: The discontinuation of the course 'Research Design and Methodology'

If you do not complete your master's programme in academic year 2023-2024, one of the four following scenarios will apply to you (see page 2). Each scenario outlines what is expected from you upon re-enrollment in the master's program for the academic year 2024-2025.

2. Students will be required to take elective courses

1. Students start programma in 2024-2025:

For students who enrolled in the programme in 2024-2025 the course 'Skills Lab' remains mandatory for everyone to attend. From the list of compulsory courses so far, students must choose 4 out of 6 courses. In addition to these 4 courses, students choose 12 credits out of the list of electives courses.

2. Students enrolled in the programme in 2023 –2024 or earlier:

An extinction programme will be provided for students enrolled in the programme in 2023-2024 or earlier. These students must still take all 6 required courses.

- 1. International Security and Strategic Studies
- 2. European Economics
- 3. Institution and Governance of the European Union
- 4. International Political Economy
- 5. World Politics
- 6. Modern Diplomacy
