



Programme Changes: Bachelor in Social Sciences 2025-2026

This document provides an overview of the programme changes that will apply to the Bachelor in Social Sciences starting from the academic year 2025-2026. The following changes will be implemented:

- Semester change for two courses in the first year (BA1)
- <u>Title change of a BA2 subject</u>
- New course in the Communication Studies orientation (BA3)
- <u>Semester change for two courses in the Political Sciences orientation (BA3)</u>
- <u>New course in the electives module of methodological courses (BA3)</u>

First Year (BA1)

Starting from the academic year 2025-2026, two courses will change semester:

- 'Introduction to Sociology', currently a first-semester course, will become a second-semester course.
- 'Introduction to SPC Methodology', currently a second-semester course, will become a firstsemester course.

If you are currently enrolled in one or both of these courses and do not pass, you will need to retake them in the corresponding semester next academic year.

If you have not passed **'Economy and Society'**, you will be required to take the course under its new title, **'Political Economy'**, as of academic year 2025-2026.

Third year (BA3): Communication studies

Starting from the academic year 2025-2026, the compulsory first semester course '**Cultural Media Studies**' in the Communication Studies orientation will be substituted with a new first semester course titled '**Visual Culture'**.

- Students who are <u>currently enrolled</u> in 'Cultural Media Studies' for the academic year 2024-2025 and <u>do not successfully complete</u> the course will be required to take the new course in the following academic year.
- Students who are <u>currently enrolled</u> in 'Cultural Media Studies' for the academic year 2024 2025 and <u>do successfully complete</u> the course will not experience any adjustments.
- Students who are <u>not yet enrolled</u> in '**Cultural Media Studies**' will be required to take the new course in the following academic year.

Third Year (BA3): Political Sciences

Starting from the academic year 2025-2026, two courses will change semester:

- 'History of Globalization', currently a first-semester course, will become a second-semester course.
- **'Contemporary Politics in the Global South'**, currently a second-semester course, will become a first-semester course.

If you are currently taking either course and do not pass, you will need to retake it in its new semester next year.

EXCEPTION FOR EARLY GRADUATION: Students eligible for an early graduation may be affected by History of Globalization moving to the second semester. If this impacts your graduation plan and you meet the <u>early graduation criteria</u>, you may **substitute History of Globalization with a free elective**. This elective may be:

- A course from another orientation, or
- A second methodological course.

Third Year (BA3): Methodological Electives

Starting from the academic year 2025-2026, the elective course **'Digital Methods'** will be discontinued and will no longer be offered in the programme. Instead, a new course, **'Audience Research'**, will be introduced.

Students who are currently enrolled in **'Digital Methods'** and do not pass in the 2025-2026 academic year will need to select a new elective course of their choice in the following year.
