Studies or Traineeship

- Always <u>during</u> & <u>part</u> of your VUB studies, never after graduation (excl. Erasmus+ Traineeship after graduation)
- English or local language? Make sure to check

Studies: course package at VUB is substituted by course package at partner institution

- You take courses and exams abroad
- Obtained credits abroad are recognised at VUB
- Grade conversion by Faculty (not always a 1:1 conversion)
- Destination depending on existing agreements

Traineeship: as part of your VUB programme that contains an internship (ECTS)

host organisation selected by student and approved by exchange coordinator






ERASMUS+ KA1 GRANTS



- Limited funding available: ranking by faculty based on faculty criteria
- If you receive an Erasmus+ grant → Max. funding of 6 months
 - With exception of students belonging to the fewer opportunities category

- Flemish study allowance (Vlaamse Studietoelage)

- Working student : very specific conditions, different definition from VUB working student

INCLUSION SUPPORT

- Min. 8 weeks of scholarship (=between €400 €1000 depending on situation)
- Faculty ranking if needed

EXCHANGE GRANT (BUITENLANDTOELAGE)

- Managed by the study finance department
- Several conditions
 - Only for exchanges in which you complete part of your study curriculum.
 - Calculated on the basis of the number of months abroad
 - I Family indexed cadastral income may not exceed € 1.250
 - Not combinable with rent allowance
 - Nationality or residency requirements
 - Grant amount variable Up to € 270/month
- Apply before departure

STUDIES

- BA3, MA1 or MA2 check ideal semesters for your programme
- Student proposes course list (min. 21 ECTS), but always in dialogue with exchange coordinator
- Depending on the possibilities of the host institution and availability (changes!)

TRAINEESHIP

- During MA1/MA2 or first year after MA studies
- Internship or thesis
- Master degree is required for internships after studies
- Not limited to partner list



Exchange during studies

- Studies or traineeship abroad
- counts as part of VUB programme
- transcript of records, but no certificate/degree from host university
- grade conversion
- thesis is exception you still defend at VUB + final grade given by VUB / co-promotor at host





What to take into account when choosing a destination?

Studies:

- > Only when there is an agreement between universities / relevant departments
- > Look closely at offered courses, teaching language, etc.
- ➤ Non-EU: min. GPA, language test required, etc.

Traineeship:

- > Anywhere
- Traineeship agreement needed between company / organization and VUB
- Important to follow the guidelines of your programme
- Sometimes bilateral agreement required (e.g. Swiss and UK HEI)
 - > ETH Zürich all study fields
 - University of Gibraltar Biology / Oceans & Lakes



Traineeship after studies

- There must be a direct link with your current studies
- Can be either to an EU or non-EU country. Funding for non-EU traineeships is limited
- Nomination at VUB and start of application before graduation!
- No motivation letter or specific destination needed in nomination phase

What are the next steps?

- Individual contact with exchange coordinator of your programme
- 12 December: deadline non-EU exchange application to exchange coordinator
 - ✓ Studies or Traineeship/Thesis
 - ✓ Destination + semester
 - ✓ Motivation letter in ENG (max. 1 page) personal and academic motivation
 - √ Transcript of records
- 23 February: deadline EU (E+/SEMP) exchange application to exchange coordinator
 - √ Studies or Traineeship/Thesis
 - ✓ Destination + semester
 - ✓ For traineeship you can indicate 'to be decided'
 - ✓ Motivation letter in ENG (max. 1 page) personal and academic motivation
 - √ Transcript of records
- Faculty ranking (70% grades, 30% motivation + 5% bonus for fewer opportunities)
- Final permission for **departure** after deliberation in June or September
