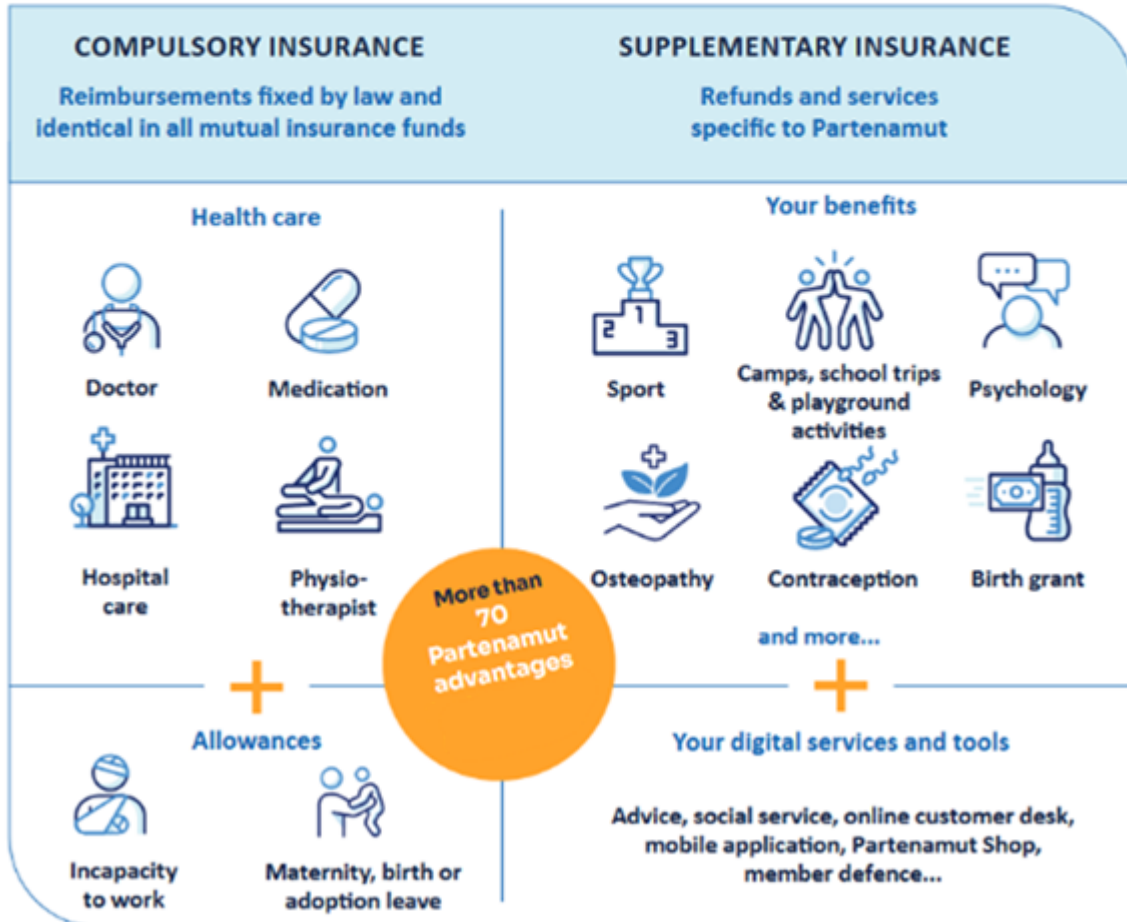


HEALTH CARE IN BELGIUM

- Belgium offers a **public** health care system of high-quality
- **Free choice** of doctor, hospital, pharmacy, etc.
- **Partial reimbursement** of health care expenses: *Doctor (also dentist and specialist), Medication, Hospitalization and Dental.*
- Reimbursements (between 60% to 80%) are **based on the national price fixed** by the National Institute for Sickness and Invalidity Insurance (INAMI/RIZIV).

Your health cover **deciphered**

Discover everything that makes up your Partenamut cover and enjoy a multitude of reimbursements and benefits in all areas of health and well-being.



- Sports 50€/year - sport club
- Quit smoking up to 100€/year (medicine, nicotine substitutes)
- Contraception 50€/year (pill, patch, condoms...@pharmacy)
- Vaccines up to 35€/year (e.g. human papillomavirus)
- Glasses and lenses up to 75€/2year
- Allergies up to 125€/year (e.g. 10€/antihistamines@pharmacy)
- Psychology and sexology up to 400€/year (20€/session + 5 free telephone consultations (freephone 0800 88 080)
- Alternative therapies up to 120€/year (homeopathy, chiropraxie, acupuncture, sophrologie, mindfulness meditation sessions)

Please note that the membership is adjusted every year.

The Reimbursement Process



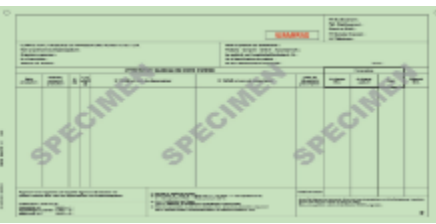
Doctor appointment



Put your identification **sticker** on the **medical attestation received** and send us the **original** attestation **by post** or drop the original paper in a **PARTENAMUT agency** nearby or **PARTENAMUT mailbox at VUB**



Hospital and emergency



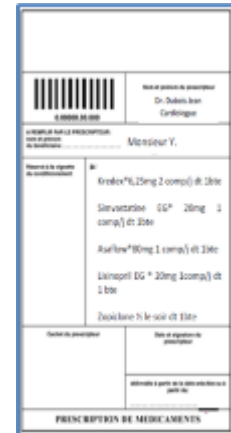
Hospital: Call and make an appointment. Show Your ID/Resident card or Partenamut sticker at the entrance.

Pay the visit and send us the claims for reimbursement, don't forget to put your identification sticker on it

Emergency: Go directly to the hospital via the emergency services.



Pharmacy



Show the **medical prescription**, your ID/Resident card or the Helan sticker
In case you don't have an ID/Resident card or a Helan sticker yet : ask for the **annex 30**, put your sticker on it and send us the receipt for reimbursement

(1) Art 118 of the coordinated law of July 14th 1994 (free choice of health insurance provider) – Art 252 of the Royal Decree of July 3th 1996 (request for registration to a health insurance company)
(2) The Belgian national number can be found on the back of the ID card, in the top left corner. It starts with your year of birth.
(3) The number of your health insurance company is made up of three numbers and can be found on your identification stickers, for ex: 509
(4) Accredited members of diplomatic missions and of consular representations as well as their staff who are holders of a special ID card cannot be registered in the 'Belgian national registry' as indicated in article 3, §1,15° of the law regarding mandatory health care and benefits, coordinated on July 14th 1994.

=> You can register under the student status

- **No registration at the city hall yet or in progress:**
Complete and sign the registration form both sides in capital letters
Provide us the following documents:
 - ✓ VUB registration certificate
 - ✓ Copy of passport + copy visa D
- Please bring the documents to the PARTENAMUT VUB office (see next slide)
- After your registration is completed at the city hall, you have the possibility to switch your registration status from student to resident so that you do not have to pay the full amount.

Once your Partenamut registration documents will be processed:

Confirmation letter sent by post

Personalized stickers to be used to claim reimbursement

The Partenamut reimbursement box is situated at Pleinlaan 5 (inside ground floor)



Manage your online health insurance “My Partenamut”

Activate your account "My Partenamut": apply for benefits, order stickers, view your file, download proof of insurance for the townhall, etc.
