

Biography Ambassador Stefan Tinca

Ambassador S. Tinca has joined the Romanian Ministry of Foreign Affairs in 1995, as diplomatic attaché in the UN Directorate. Between 1997 and 2000 he worked within Romanian Mission to the EU.

Between 2000 - 2002, he returned to the MFA as Director for the European Union.

Between 2002 and 2006, he was back to the Mission of Romania to the EU, as counsellor in charge for ESDP and the European Parliament.

In 2006 he returned to the MFA, first as Deputy Political Director, then, between 2007 and 2011, as Political Director of the MFA. From April 2011 until July 2012, he was appointed Director General for Regional Affairs within the MFA (dealing with East-Central Europe, the Western Balkans, Central Asia and regional cooperation), before being accredited as Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Romania to the Kingdom of Belgium, in October 2012.

Ambassador S. Tinca is a graduate of the Faculty of Mathematics, University of Bucharest (1995). He holds a PhD degree from *Babes-Bolyai University* in Cluj-Napoca. His doctoral thesis was focused on 'A Model for the Transatlantic Relationship at the Beginning of the XXIst Century'.
