Trained in clinical psychology and psychotherapy, Ramona Simut Vanderborght provides psychological services to children and their families, individually or in groups, especially in areas of: (1) psychodiagnosis and treatment of neurodevelopmental disorders (e. g. autism spectrum disorder- ASD, attention deficit hyperactivity disorder) and mood disorders (e.g. anxiety,depression) and (2) parental training. She is certified as a Circle of Security® Parenting™ facilitator. Her practice is based on the attachment theory and cognitive-behavioral therapy. She has extensive training in early interventions (behavioral, play, sensorial therapy etc.) and more than five years experience as therapist and diagnostician with young children with ASD. She graduated from a master program in Clinical psychology, psychological counseling and psychotherapy, with a CBT formation at Babes-Bolyai University, Romania. From September 2011 to present, she follows a doctoral program, with the research focus on the clinical use of social robots for children with ASD, at the Clinical and Life Span Psychology Department of Vrije Universiteit Brussel.
