

WHO

Because of the interdisciplinarity, the Sustainability Bootcamp appeals to a wide and diverse range of potential participants with different backgrounds.

HOW

The Sustainability Bootcamp consists out of one introductory session, followed by four thematic modules spread out over the four days and an active closing activity.

SUSTAINABILITY CHALLENGE

In this first module, we introduce you to the current challenge of human kind.

STATE-OF-THE-ART

In the second module, we give you a view on where we stand today, via topics as energy, mobility&logistics and buildings.

AUTHORITIES AND COMPANIES

In this third module we look into the responsibilities on a more central level: politics and mitigations strategies; strategy and CSR; production and the circular economy model.

INDIVIDUAL LEVEL

In this last module we give you an insight on the different initiatives one can take as an individual: sustainable food, how to work in an sustainable way, what can we really do ourselves.
